Safety Equipment, Bout Structure & Dress Code

SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

- The WSKE Executive Board, Together with the Technical Committee must approve all safety equipment. Producers of safety equipment must get their products approved by WSKE.
- Safeties to be used is State, National, World and all championships must be approved at least one month before the tournaments and all members must be duly informed.
- All uniforms and safety equipment must be clean, correct and in good and safe condition. Special care must be taken for weapons which must not be sharp or with unprotected points.

MANFATORY SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

This is required or you will not be allowed to compete.

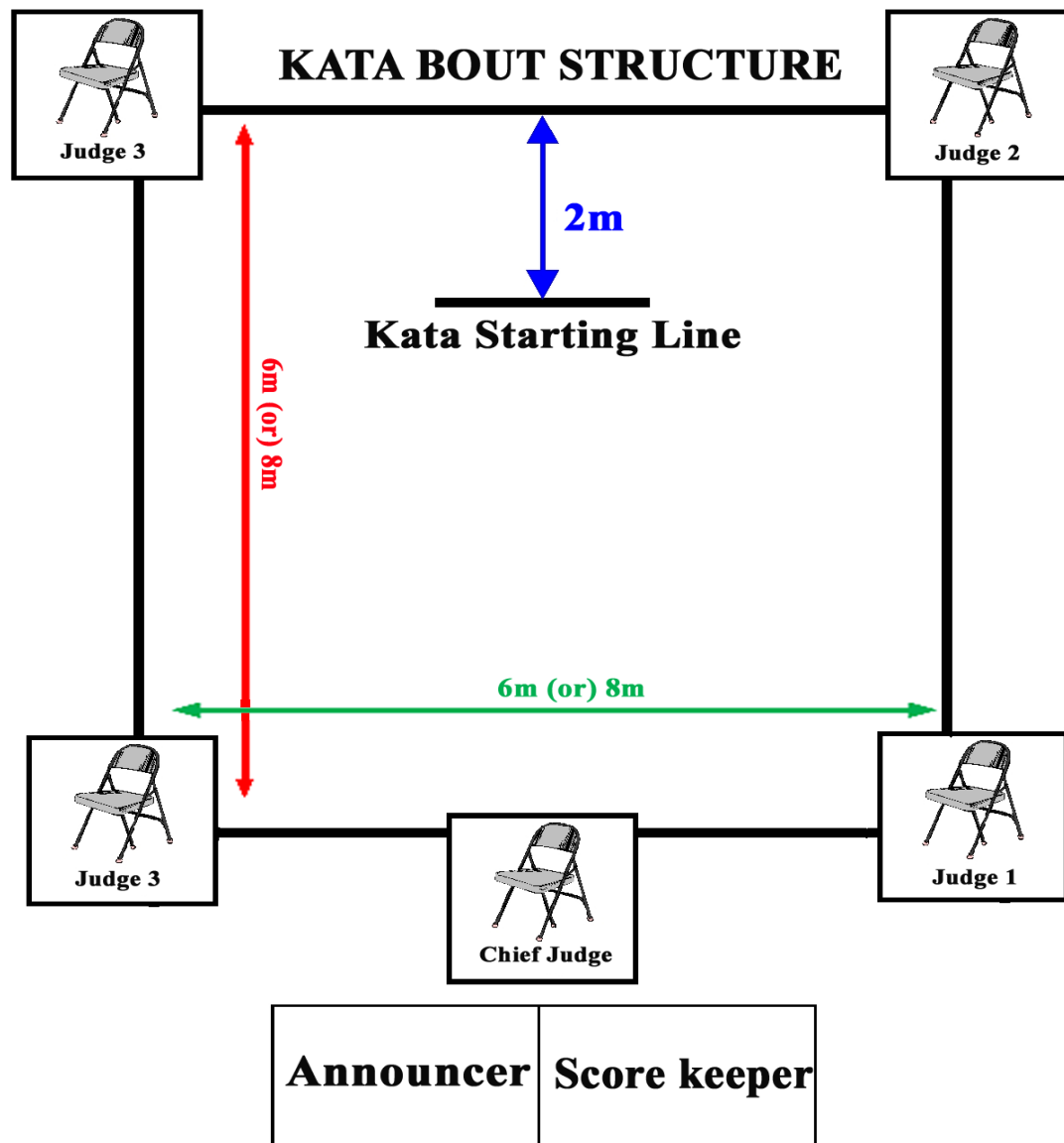
OPTIONAL SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

This equipment is recommended and optional.

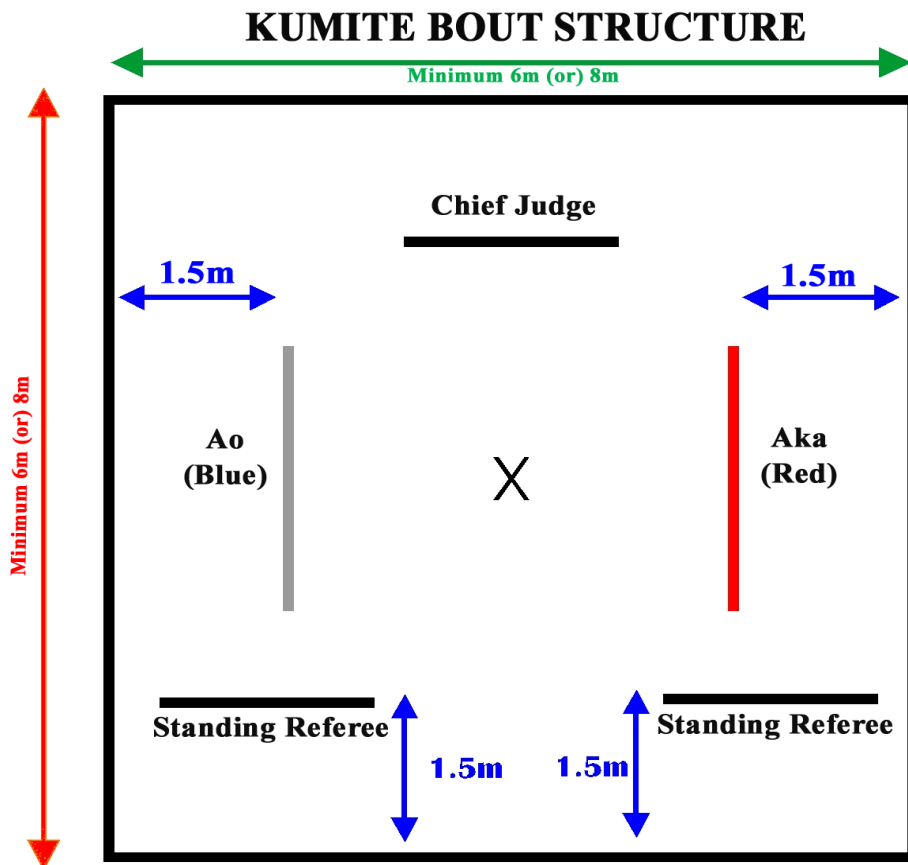

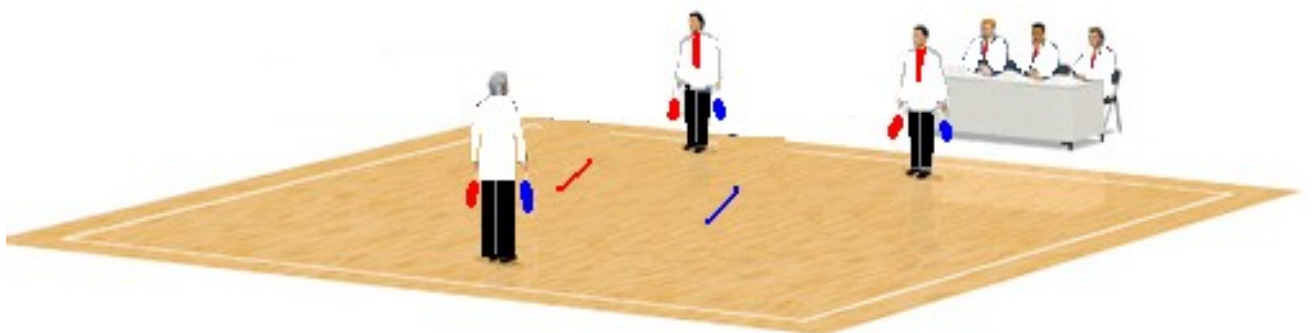
MEASUREMENTS OF KATA COMPETITION AREA
